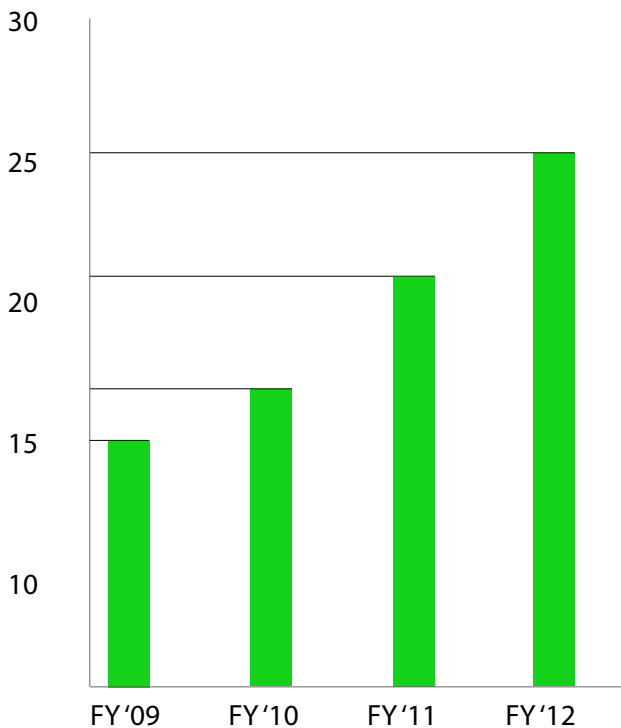

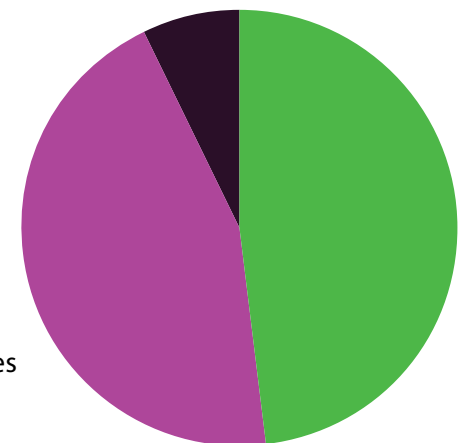
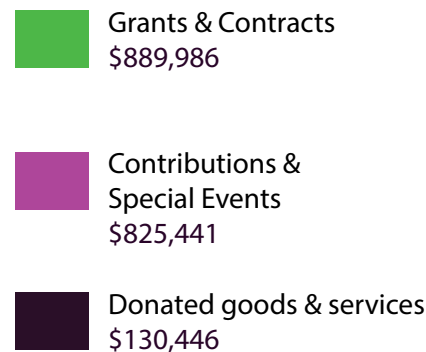
I am pleased to report that A-SPAN continues to provide emergency needs services for some of the most vulnerable people in Arlington County – those living on the streets. Then we work to help them address long-term root causes of homelessness, and ultimately get them in housing and off the streets for good. We changed our tag line to “Ending Homelessness in Arlington” to reflect this. This past year, A-SPAN spearheaded Arlington’s involvement in the national 100,000 Homes Campaign, which aims to place 100,000 people in housing by 2014 across the country. These types of efforts illustrate our commitment to ending homelessness in Arlington by helping homeless people get into housing. For those efforts and our continued service to people experiencing homelessness in Arlington County, A-SPAN was named the 2011 Nonprofit of the Year by the Arlington Chamber of Commerce.
