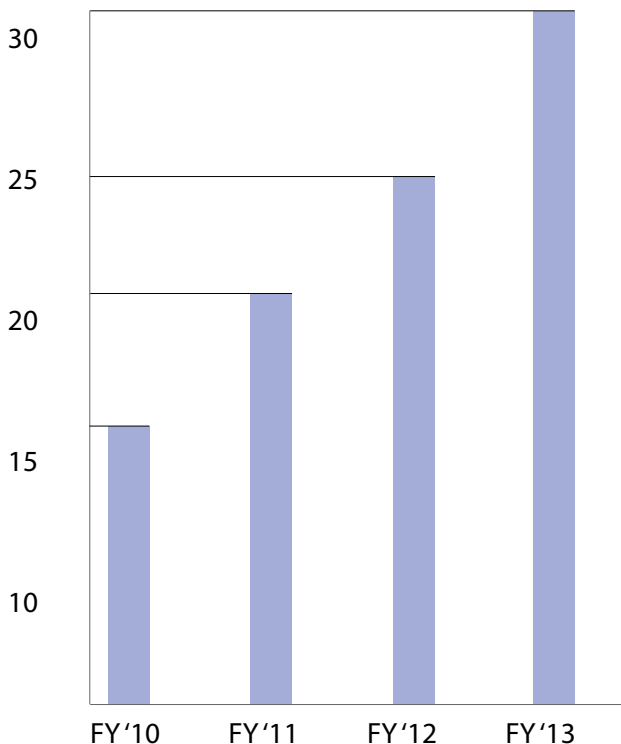

## From our Executive Director, Kathleen Sibert

I am pleased to report that A-SPAN continues to make progress towards Ending Homelessness in Arlington by placing people in housing and supporting them once they are in their own apartment, and by also improving the systems that are in place to do so. We now have a full time 100 Homes Case Manager who works closely with partner organizations in coordinating housing placement for the 153 people who were identified as in need of housing through Arlington's 100 Homes Campaign. So far, 58 people are now in housing through 100 Homes, including eight formerly homeless veterans through a partnership with Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing. A major step towards improving all of our services was taken on November 20, 2012 when the Arlington County Board moved to purchase the property at 2020 North 14th street that will devote two floors to a Homeless Services Center and a Year-Round Shelter. This will open up beds year-round, and provide the regular contact case managers need with clients to help even more people in need get into housing. Thank you for your continued support!

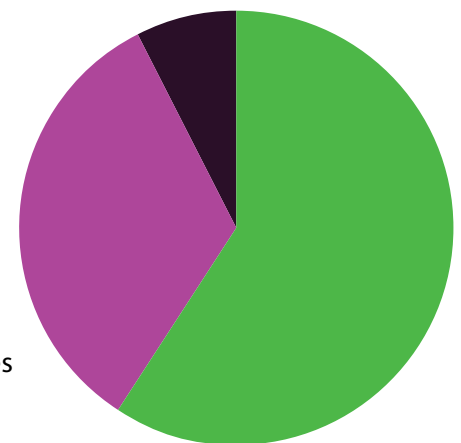
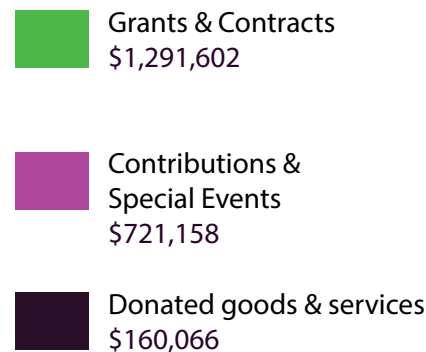
## Growth Permanent Supportive Housing From 17 in FY 2010 to 31 in FY 2013
